



Great Yarmouth Port Authority is looking to appoint a new Board Member

Appointments will be for a three year period and each member is eligible for re-appointment on two subsequent three year periods. The start date for this appointment is expected to be 1st February 2027.

Great Yarmouth Port Authority is the Statutory Harbour Authority and Competent Harbour Authority for the Port of Great Yarmouth and the reversionary landlord of the port estate. The Port, which is operated by Peel Ports, is a modern, multipurpose facility with 24/7 unrestricted operations comprising of a deep-water outer harbour and the riverport.

GYPA's current non-executive board is appointed under the terms of the GYPA(Constitution) Harbour Revision Order (HRO) 2015.

The HRO requires that each Member appointed by the selection panel must be a person with knowledge and qualifications, experience or ability in one or more of the following matters: (a) management of ports or pilotage; (b) shipping and marine transport; (c) legal, financial or property matters; (d) marine safety and environmental matters; (e) management of water related leisure activities; (f) any other skills and abilities the selection panel considers to be relevant to the functions of the Board.

Commercial property experience would be particularly useful for this appointment although it is not an essential requirement for this appointment.

Board Members are expected to attend six meetings a year comprising four regular ordinary meetings, an AGM and an annual public meeting.

Board members will receive a remuneration package.
